Mahidol University Notification

Re: Rule and procedure of Mahidol University student health care service

B.E. 2559 (A.D. 2016)

Whereas it is appropriate to prescribe the rule and procedure of student health care service in order to more facilitate for student.

Be it, therefore, under the power in accordance with the statement of Section 34 of Mahidol University Act B.E. 2550 (A.D. 2007), and Clause 2(1) and Clause 5 of Mahidol University Notification Re: Accounting management of student affairs funds B.E. 2553 (A.D. 2010), the president enacted the rule and procedure of Mahidol University student health care service as follows:

1. In these notifications;

“Medical expense” means the cost of medicine, blood and blood components or hemoglobin solutions, parenteral medicinal liquid or nutrition, oxygen therapy and other similarly used in the treatment of disease, medical charges and diagnostics fees. Excluding the diagnostics service charge, the cost of pregnancy treatment and its service, the cost of chronic disease treatment prior to register as a Mahidol University student, or other surcharge such as the cost of organ, any service charge that be a consideration or beautification.

“Health care service Unit” means the health care service unit of Mahidol University.

“Affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University” means Siriraj Hospital, Ramathibodi Hospital, Hospital for Tropical Diseases, Golden Jubilee Medical Center, and Dental Hospital.

“Other hospital” means the hospitals where not affiliate with Mahidol University.

“Student” means the student who completely paid for tuition fees of university according to the notification that university prescribed in each semester.

“Funds” means the student affairs funds in accordance with Mahidol University Notification Re: Accounting management of student affairs funds.

2. Conditions of receiving the health care service.

2.1 Student who completely paid for health care service in each semester is entitled to receive the health care service of the university until the last date that Mahidol University prescribed for payment in next academic year and to have an effect until graduation or termination.

2.2 Student shall execute to have the welfare of medical care as follows:

2.2.1 Thai student shall be enroll for registered the welfare of medical care according to the student's rights as the case may be, including the Universal Healthcare Coverage Scheme, Civil Servant Medical Benefit Schemes; administered by the Comptroller General's Department), Public Enterprise Workers' Medical Benefit Scheme, or Social Security Scheme. The student shall disburse the expenses his/her welfare of medical care in accordance with the rule and procedure in these notifications attached hereto.

Student who is enroll for registered the welfare of medical care incomplete yet and cannot exercise the rights while the medical treatment expense incurred, the university shall grant subsidy from the fund for a student in maximum amount 30,000 Baht per year. To grant the subsidy shall be in a case of receiving the health care service from the affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University only.

2.2.2 International student shall get the coverage in accordance with the health insurance that given by the unit of Mahidol University, and must has minimum coverages as follows:

(1) In-patient Hospitalization (IPD) Coverages.

(1.1) Room and board (per day, minimum 31 days).

(1.2) ICU Room (per day, minimum 7 days).

(1.3) General Expenses (e.g. ambulance fee / IPD treatment).

(1.4) Surgeon's operation fee.

(1.5) In-patient physician visit fee (per day, minimum 31 days).

(1.6) Emergency OPD treatment for accident.

(1.7) Special consultation fee.

(2) Out-patient Benefits (OPD) maximum one time per day, and minimum 30 times per year.

2.3 When student has the exceeding expense from his/her welfare under clause 2.2 due to the physician has opinion that there is necessary, or prescribing besides the National

List of Essential Medicines according to the attachments, Mahidol University shall grant the expense from its fund to the student not over 30,000 Baht per academic year. Except in case the university approves more grant over previously mentioned expense, vice president who is an appointee of the president shall have a discretion to consider case by case and that case shall be the health care service receipt from the following hospitals:

(1) Affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University.

(2) Phutthamonthon Hospital.

(3) Any hospital where Mahidol University has the agreement or the service cooperation for the student of provincial campuses as follows;

(3.1) Kanchanaburi Campus, namely, Sai Yok Hospital or Phanhon Phon Phayuha Sena Hospital.

(3.2) Amnatcharoen Campus Project, i.e., Amnatcharoen Hospital.

(3.3) Nakhon Sawan Campus Project, namely, Mahidol Nakhon Sawan Medical Center, Khao Thong Health Promoting Hospital, Payuha Khiri Hospital, or Sawanpracharak Hospital.

2.4 Student shall receive the health care service at the hospital according to university's stipulations as follows:

2.4.1 During office hours are able to receive the service at the health care service unit of the faculty where student enrolled, or the faculty where located nearby, or the affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University, according to the rules of student health care service unit or the affiliated hospitals are prescribed.

2.4.2 The outside office hours are able to receive the service at the affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University, according to the rules, times and places of affiliated hospitals are prescribed.

2.4.3 Emergency case or accidents are able to receive the service from the following health care service units and hospitals subsequently:

(1) The student health care service unit where is the nearest.

(2) Affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University.

(3) Other hospital where student can use his/her welfare.

2.5 Conditions of Mahidol University's dental service.

(1) Student shall receive a pre-study oral examination of Mahidol University according the prescribed date, time and place, and complete the dental treatment before

starting the education. In case if necessary to receive the dental services during study, student shall receive the health care service, according the prescribed lists in these notifications attached hereto.

(2) If student receives the dental treatment aside from the prescribed lists, or there is an exceeding expense from the university prescribed as (1), the student shall be responsible that exceeding expense, or use his/her welfare instead.

2.6 When student is dismissed, he/she shall contact for registering to the Universal Healthcare Scheme at the hospital where is in the area of the student's permanent address.

2.7 In the event of the student need to receive medical treatment urgently, and the university cannot provide a car for transportation, student is able to claim the traveling expense in amount maximum 500 Baht per time.

2.8 In the event of the student need to use an ambulance for transportation, student is able to claim the ambulance fee in amount maximum 2,000 Baht per one person, or per time as the case maybe. The ambulance fee payable shall be suitable with the distance.

2.9 When student is sick and got hospitalized in the hospital, or receiving the special treatment, the division that is responsible of student affairs shall provide a visiting patient gift for the student in amount 1,000 to 2,000 Baht per one person, or per time as the case maybe.

2.10 Student shall show his/her identification (ID) card and student card to the health care service unit, affiliated hospitals with Mahidol University, and other hospitals for checking the rights of received health care service or dental service.

2.11 Student who receives a tuition fee exemption in accordance with the notifications of any unit and the exemption is including health care service fee, he/she shall not be entitled to receive the student health care service as these notifications.

3. The payment of health care service supporting that besides the student welfare according these notifications shall pay from the fund of student affairs under the Mahidol University Notification Re: Accounting management of student affairs funds, by the president or the vice president who is an appointee of president shall be a person who has the approval power.

4. In case there is a problem to implement these notifications, the president or the vice president who is an appointee of president shall be to consider, and his/her consideration shall deemed conclusive.

These notifications shall apply from the academic year 2560 onwards.
